Introduction

The “Foundation for the Urban Environment Pierre Laconte” (FFUE) aims to promote the quality of the urban environment through conferences, debates, research, publications and other forms of communication.


The urban environment includes:

1. The proper development of urban and rural territory including their cultural heritage
2. Transport and mobility
3. The good use of resources affecting the quality of life of its inhabitants

The FFUE is a permanent institution created by a Royal Decree of August 8, 1999, published in the Belgian Official Gazette of October 1, 1999.

The initial capital of the Foundation was constituted by Pierre Laconte in a blocked bank account. Neither the president nor the directors are remunerated. Fees from any contracts or copyrights are added to the capital of the Foundation. Development expenses are covered by the founder in addition to his initial contribution. The FFUE is eligible to receive grants in line with its objectives.





1.2. BOOK 2020 LOUVAIN-LA-NEUVE AT A CROSSROAD - FOLLOW-UP

1.2.1. At the invitation of the University of Louvain (collection "Actors for the University", directed by the rector P. Crochet), P. Laconte wrote with J. Remy, a book dedicated to the Groupe Urbanisme Architecture (UA), created by the UCL Board of Directors in October 1968 (R. Lemaire, J.P. Blondel and P. Laconte), in charge of the Master Plan and the architectural coordination of the new university town of Louvain-la-Neuve. This 300-page book was released in January 2020 under the title *Louvain-la-Neuve à la croisée des chemins* (Éditions Academia-L'Harmattan).



1.3. ACTIVITIES WITHIN EUROPA NOSTRA ("THE VOICE OF EUROPEAN CULTURAL HERITAGE")

1.3.1. The Europa Nostra Committee "Industrial & Engineering Heritage Committee - IEHC", founded and chaired by the President of the FFUE, took the initiative to write a book devoted to 50 exemplary cases of industrial heritage conservation and adaptation, all having received an EU/Europa Nostra award. It was published in 2020 in English, German and French by the Donau Universität Krems, which has kept the archives of Europa Nostra since its origin. The work was entirely financed by Europa Nostra Austria.

In four-color and in A4 cardboard format, with nearly 300 pages, the book was printed in 500 copies. Out of print, it was reprinted in 2022. It is freely downloadable in electronic version. Its printed version can be purchased at Danube University Krems for €29.99.

The Venice Summit is organised by **Europa Nostra** - the European voice of civil society committed to Cultural Heritage - during the Slovenian Presidency of the Council of the EU, with the support of the **European Union**, through the Creative Europe and Horizon 2020 programmes, as well as in collaboration with other European and Italian partners.

1.5. THE HALLES SAINT-GÉRY ASSOCIATION



2.1.2. The work was followed in 2020 by:

- an update, by the same authors, of the part concerning the 'Métro Nord' project and by
- several articles in French and Dutch (*La Libre*, *Le Vif*, *Ruimte*, and *Ruimte en Maatschappij*). The latest "carte blanche" was published in *La Libre*.

The 'Métro Nord' project is the subject of controversy about its usefulness (low foreseeable demand for passenger traffic for a deep tunnel of 5 km, at an estimated cost of 3 billion euros).

An action was brought by four associations (including the FFUE) before the Council of State against the Region. The latter had decided to build the first station of the Métro Nord project on the eve of the last elections. The result of this action has not yet been communicated to the applicants.



Play these possibilities could be used is shown by **members of the Architecture Section** together with their **guests**, presenting samples of their own work in Biennale-style. This project, visions and debates in the field of architecture, design and landscape architecture, the result of which demonstrate a broad range of ideas for the city of the future, from design details to urban planning vision, from building technology to political strategy. The result is a kaleidoscope of concepts, a tour d'horizon into current European architecture and urban planning and that follows the pressing issues of our day: energy, digitalisation, mobility, the culture of density, or relation to nature, reuse, recycling, and existing structures as well as technical innovations.

An **room installation** of images by Berlin photographer Erik-Jan Ouwerkerk forms an urban panorama, which – supplemented by facts from research by the Institute of Urban Design and Planning at Leibniz University Hannover – introduces the subject and deals with the topics of traffic, sustainability, regional city construction scheme, building denationalization, technical innovation and social life.

3.2. INTERNATIONAL COLLOQUIUM DANUBE UNIVERSITAT KREMS (DUK) "SYMBOLIC VALUE OF INDUSTRIAL HERITAGE" (1/7/2022)

3.2.1. Objective of the colloquium

The symposium was initiated by the "Industrial and Engineering Heritage Committee" (IEHC), founded and chaired by the president of the FFUE, Pierre Laconte. Its aim was to broaden the contribution of industrial heritage to the urban and rural environment from the shipyards of Gdansk to historic fish ponds, rich in symbolic and historical elements.



Il se limite dans le cas présent à la Belgique, siège de la Fondation.

Équipe éditoriale

L'équipe de contributeurs qui coordonne l'ouvrage comprend Michel Bande, CSR Europe, ancien VP, Solvay SA; Pierre Coërs, CSR Europe, Solvay SA , Pierre Laconte, Président FFUE; Jean-Marie Postiaux, CEO Pair Daiza Foundation, et Bruno Clerbaux, architecte urbaniste ACP Group, Past SG European Council of Spatial Planners. La première partie évoque, au travers de cinq initiatives abouties ou avortées, un pays fragmenté mais créatif, contraint mais fertile. A les parcourir, c'est un laboratoire de la complexité, mais aussi du mariage des contraires, de l'expérimentation, des tentatives de contournement de l'institutionnel qui se fait jour.

En particulier la multiculturalité, qui culmine à Bruxelles, génère des difficultés d'articulation entre ses 3 Régions, constitue un pays tirailé de l'intérieur jusque dans ses choix stratégiques, y compris énergétiques, et jusque dans son enseignement, échouant à faire émerger un plan de développement durable à l'échelle du pays.


